Course Description:

The purpose of this course is to provide students with new techniques to develop, improve and enhance their current study and reading skills. Assignments from current classes will be used to promote better skills in the students' classes. Time for homework/projects will be set aside weekly. The objectives for this class include: creating and utilizing a calendar/agenda as a learning and time management tool, note taking techniques, improving reading and listening skills, perfecting comparison and proofreading skills.

Grading:

- Major grades (essays, embedded assignments, unit tests).
- Daily Grades (homework, quizzes, and weekly articles).

 - All major assignments will come with a study guide and/or rubric when assigned.

Make-up work:

There are many fun events throughout the school year, especially if you are involved in athletes, drama, ROTC, band, etc. At times, this may require you to miss class. If you know you will be out, please see me ahead of time to get your work. ALL make-up work is your responsibility. Please do not fall behind because you do not complete make-up work. Late work:

I will not be accepting late work for daily grades (homework, quizzes, weekly articles). If you do not have it on the day it is due, it will be counted as a zero. Major grades, including essays will be accepted one day late for half credit.

Extra credit:

There will be NO extra credit offered in this class. You will not be able to make up any missing work at the last minute. However, I will drop your lowest <u>daily</u> grade at the end of the nine weeks (not tests, essays, or quizzes). Please keep up with your grades on a daily basis by checking GradeLine and discuss any class discrepancies with me immediately.

Cell phones:

Please do not use your cell phone in class unless I give you permission- the sign on the board will indicate if you can have it out. Please keep your phone on silent. If you are using it while I am lecturing, reading, or holding a class discussion, you will be asked to place your phone on my desk for the class period. You should not be using it while you are supposed to be working in class. If it becomes a distraction, you will receive a discipline referral.

Tardies:

We will follow the GBHS tardy policy.
